### 2) INFORM OUR COMMUNITY

- Provide clear, independent commentary and review of education policy issues.
- Highlight and expand the use of evidence-based best practices in classrooms.

### 3) SUPPORT EDUCATORS

- Help create and facilitate professional development for educators in the areas of leadership and STEM education.
- Provide teacher grants focused on innovative classroom instruction and aligned with WCPSS priorities.
- Connect business volunteers with schools to meet defined instructional needs.

## EXAMPLES OF OUR WORK

### We support or partner with these local, statewide and national initiatives:

- WAKE Up and Read: WCPSS Early childhood literacy initiative, book drives, and school-based grants.
- NC Public Schools: Every child's chance; every community's future – Statewide campaign by NC Association of School Administrators.

### Ongoing WEP Programs and Initiatives:

- Teacher Innovation Grants: Innovative classroom grants to teachers (over \$1M invested to date).
- SummerSTEM: Connecting educators with STEM professionals to enhance instruction and develop globally competitive students.
- World Café: Roundtable connecting teachers with business leaders to identify STEM career opportunities for students.
- First Steps in Literacy: Collaboration with schools, families, and community literacy leaders to invest in families' ability to support their children's school readiness.
- Partners Read: Collaboration with businesses and professional organizations to place mentors into WCPSS elementary schools to support elementary literacy.
- Stars of Education: Annual event honors WCPSS educators and others making an impact on student achievement.
- Education Forum: Annual event focused on a discussion of public education policy issues and their impact on WCPSS.
